On Sunday, October 20th, Rockland's law enforcement family remembered the tragic events of the Brinks Robbery at a memorial service on Mountainview Avenue in Nyack.

In 1981, <u>Sergeant Ed O'Grady</u>, <u>Officer Waverly Brown</u>, and Brinks guard <u>Peter Paige</u> were killed during a robbery. Members of the Black Liberation Army and Weather Underground robbed a Brinks armored truck of \$1.6 million in Nanuet.
